From December 15, 2022 to January 15, 2023, North Slope Borough Dispatch in Utqiagvik recorded 986 calls for service.

- 144 were called in on 9-1-1
- 479 were officer-initiated contacts
- 40 were in-person

Of the 871 calls for Police service:

- 23 arrests were made (Adults)
- 05 were Warrant Arrests
- 13 were Domestic Violence Related
- 11 were Drug Related
- 89 were Alcohol Related
- 01 Juvenile Arrests
- 02 were Detoxed
- 02 Incidents involved Taxi Cabs
- 145 were Non-Criminal in nature
- 07 were Mental Health related

Drug and Alcohol Seizures:

During the month there were 3 incidents where alcoholic beverages were seized and placed into evidence. (approximately 8 bottles of spirits & 20 Liters of wine)
