SUBJECT: Utqiagvik – Monthly Report for February 2023

From January 15, 2022 to February 15, 2023, North Slope Borough Dispatch in Utqiagvik recorded 1020 calls for service.

- 144 were called in on 9-1-1
- 468 were officer-initiated contacts
- 36 were in-person

Of the 871 calls for Police service:

- 30 arrests were made (Adults)
- 13 were Warrant Arrests
- 17 were Domestic Violence Related
- 16 were Drug Related
- 105 were Alcohol Related
- 01 Juvenile Arrests
- 06 were Detoxed
- 02 Incidents involved Taxi Cabs
- 212 were Non-Criminal in nature
- 03 were Mental Health related

Drug and Alcohol Seizures:

During the month there were 3 incidents where alcoholic beverages were seized and placed into evidence. (approximately 1 btl of spirits)

1 - 750 ml btl Canadian Whiskey (02/12/2023)
1 - partial btl R&R (01/13/2023)

During the month there were 2 incidents where drugs were seized and placed into evidence.

- Vape pens
- Unspecified amount of Fentanyl pills
- Unspecified amount of marijuana

During the month there was 4 incidents where drug/narcotics equipment were seized and placed into evidence.

Note: these figures presented are only on cases that are closed and forwarded for prosecution; they don't include active investigations or joint investigations with other agencies.
