- The Alaska Municipal League (AML) came to Utqiagvik and did a Video Interview on what it's like to be a rural Mayor in Alaska. This will be presented at the Annual AML Conference followed by a Q&A.
- ❖ I met with the US Department of Energy where we had a fluid conversation about global warming and the effects in the arctic and where we are successful and where want to see change.
- ❖ AFLAC came to the City and was available to our staff for more information and opportunity to learn more and where it can benefit our employees. Department of Retirement and Benefits will also be coming to the City of Utgiaġvik in November.
- ❖ Arctic Insights & Solutions LLC has started the NPR-A working group up again.
- ❖ We took the opportunity to meet with Michal Conor, US Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works about the SeaWall.
- UIC Completed 3 land surveys for the City. The land between middle and 3<sup>rd</sup> lagoon, the land near Bakers Construction, and our gravesite at Emiksoun.

  - Ballots have been ordered. Machine keys from Dominion Voting have been programmed. We
    are accepting absentee ballots from now until October 2, 2023. We have already received
    mail-out requests and send them out. We are starting to go to the home bound voters for
    their absentee votes.
  - Clerk Patkotak and Clerk Lambrecht have applied to be Notary Publics and sent the application and fees.
  - All fall scholarships were sent out for the students. We have not yet received any spring scholarships applications.
