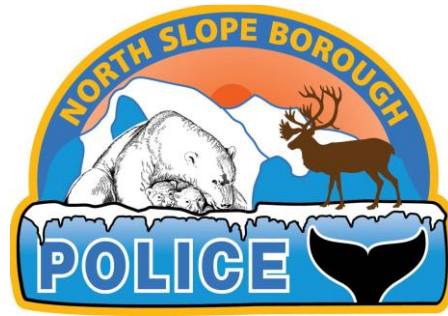

SUBJECT: Utqiagvik – Monthly Report for Sept 2023

From August 15, 2023 to September 15, 2023, North Slope Borough Dispatch in Utqiagvik recorded 906 calls for service.

Of the 906 calls for Police service: 593 were dispatched

- 106 were called in on 9-1-1
- 40 were in-person
- 344 were officer-initiated contacts

395 calls for service for the following

- 28 arrests were made (Adults)
- 10 were Warrant Arrests
- 26 were Domestic Violence Related
- 12 were Drug Related
- 91 were Alcohol Related
- 03 Juvenile Arrests
- 11 were Detoxed
- 02 Incidents involved Taxi Cabs
- 141 were Non-Criminal in nature
- 11 were Mental Health related

Drug and Alcohol Seizures:

During the month there were 4 incidents where alcoholic beverages were seized and placed into evidence.

- 1 - 750 ml R&R Whiskey (08/18/2023)
- 1 - 50 ml Fireball (9/01/2023)
- 1 - 375 Gold Rum (9/01/2023)
- 10 - 12 oz Cider (9/01/2023)
- 1 - 3 L Bota Box Wine (9/01/2023)
- 3 - 12 oz Hard Seltzer (9/01/2023)
- 12 - 750 ml Sailor Boy Rum (9/01/2023)
- 8 - 750 ml R & R Whiskey (9/01/2023)
- 3 - 750 ml Vodka (9/01/2023)
- 1 - partial btl Guragao (9/01/2023)
- 1 - Partial btl St Germail (9/01/2023)

During the month there were 4 incidents where drugs were seized and placed into evidence. (approximately 2 grams methamphetamine/29.8 grams marijuana)

- 1.5 grams Marijuana (8/26/2023)
- 1-gram Methamphetamine (8/27/2023)
- 229 pills 750MG levetiracetam (9/07/2023)
- 66 pills 40 MGAatorvastatin (9/07/2023)

During the month there were 0 incidents where drug/narcotics equipment were seized and placed into evidence.

Note: these figures presented are only on cases that are closed and forwarded for prosecution; they don't include active investigations or joint investigations with other agencies.

The Police Department encourages the willingness of citizens to assist us in the "War On Drugs" campaign. The majority of the information gathered comes from YOU.
