Dear Mrs. Toovak:

I am writing to you on behalf of the eleven (11) Whaling Villages and Commissioners of the Alaska Eskimo Whaling Commission (AEWC). The AEWC is a not-for-profit corporation and a federally recognized Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) charitable and educational organization IRS No. 92-0081760.

As you are aware, the Inupiat and Siberian Yupik Eskimos living in these coastal villages of the Arctic Ocean, Beaufort and Chukchi Seas, have been hunting the bowhead whale for thousands of years. The AEWC was formed in 1977 with a mission of protecting the bowhead whale and its habitat, as well as the aboriginal subsistence traditional hunting rights of Alaska's indigenous people. The whaling communities along the Arctic Coast of Alaska rely on the AEWC to protect the bowhead whale and successfully manage the bowhead whale subsistence hunt. In a continued effort to protect and preserve the subsistence way of life for these whaling communities, AEWC is hosting its 2024 Whaling Captains' Convention and Open Water Season Conflict Avoidance Agreement (CAA) Meeting from January 29-February 2, 2024 in Utqiagvik, Alaska.
