Arctic Education Foundation Regional Culture Camp Estimated Budget

Narrative:

The AEF Regional Culture Camp is held for youth ages 12-14 years old for 1-week in July. Staff are hired for the week of camp, both river boats and ocean boats need to be leased and boat drivers (guides) hired to haul supplies, and bring the camp up and down river for daily subsistence activities. During this camp, youth are reconnected to their Inupiat roots and immersed in cultural knowledge and activities.

Camp Food:	7,000	Food purchased to feed all camp staff and youth
Camp Insurance:	30,000	quoted from insurance provider
Camp Marketing Materials:	5,000	Creation/updating of marketing materials to promote culture camp
